w/Ortha & six children

1845 Provincial Gov. Land
Grant 640 acres; site of
modern Carlton. House and
barn, Park & Polk Street

Blacksmith/ Farmer

1848 Methodist Mission at
his farm

1855 Deeded land to the
Methodist Episcopal Church
on W. Main.
Buried at this site.

WILSON CARL



b. 1827 Amity, Pennsylvania
oldest of nine orphaned
children
m. 1856 Mary Stout
d. 1897 Carlton, Or

1853 Oregon Trail
Wagoneer for Dr. & Mrs.
Knight

Carpenter/ Shoemaker

1854 Built a house known as
Mountain House, just over
Reservoir Hill.

1859 Bought farm acreage

1850's Supervised
Construction of first Baptist
(Linfield) Col. buildings.

1868 Developed place as
stage stop, post office &
blacksmith

1868-1874 Postmaster

WILLIAM A. HOWE

b. 1859 Longwood, Mass.
m. 1889 A.H. Cunningham
d. 1934 Portland, Or
Desc. Of Gen. Lord Howe,
Rev. War

1881 Grad. Of Harvard
Classmate of C.E. Ladd, son
of Mayor of Portland.
Classmate of Thayer,
inventor of baseball catchers'
mask. Rumored
collaboration.

1882 Business in New York

1883 – 1891 Farmed 700
acres in Carlton. Owned land
in Dawson, Yukon Terr.

1891-2 Builds largest
mercantile store in Carlton
(west of Legion Hall)

1903 Donates land for jail

1903 -1910 Owns Carlton
Creamery (Elevator ofc.,
now Scott Paul)

1904-06 Furnishes gas for
lights and fuel

1904 Builds dam on Yamhill
River

1904 Owns Carlton Elevator
(Madsen Grain)

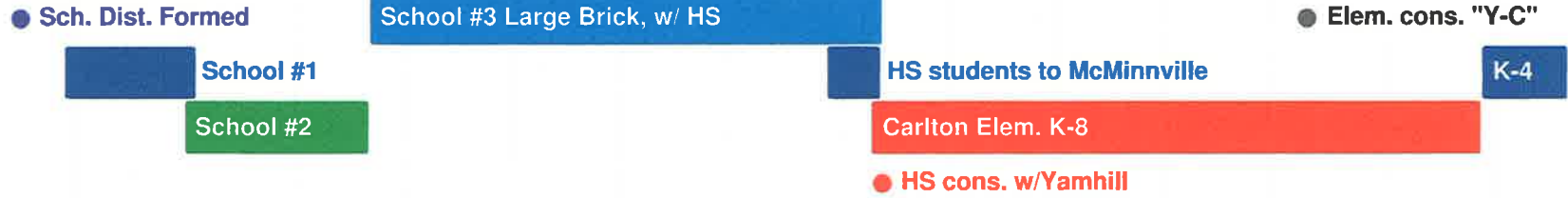

Present Carlton.</p> <p>(After unsuccessfully trying to get RR line near his property.)</p> <p>1873 Built White Cloud Sch. #1 at "Carl's Gate"; same site as #2, converted to house.</p> <p>1880's Owned the land, the current Yamhill Co. Courthouse</p> <p>Founder of McMinnville Republican Party</p> <p>Yamhill County Commissioner</p>	<p>1904 Owns W.A. Howe General Merchandise.</p> <p>Private bank in store. Makes space for James Robertson, watch repair. "Log Cabin" building</p> <p>1905 Hotel Carlton, w/ C.E. Ladd (Yamhill & Main)</p> <p>1906 Carlton Lumber Co. Incorp. w/in-law Hospital, nine beds</p> <p>1906-08 City water dist. system from wells</p> <p>1907 Electric light franchise for city.</p> <p>1910 Daughter marries son of Charles Erskine Scott Wood</p> <p>1910 Founder/Pres. of Carlton State and Savings Bank</p> <p>CEO Valley Real Estate Co.</p> <p>1920's Carlton Investment Co., real estate holdings</p> <p>State Senator</p> <p>Member of Waverley Country Club, Arlington Club, University Club, Ancient Order of United Workmen and the United Artisans</p>
