The Carlton City Council consists of a mayor and six (6) councilors. The Mayor is elected for two (2) year terms and City Councilors are elected as at-large positions for four (4) year terms. The Mayor and City Council positions are non-paid, voluntary, non-partisan positions.

The following positions are up for election on the November 3, 2020 Biennial General Election for the City of Carlton:

Should you or someone you know be interested in running for City Council, please be aware any person holding elective office in the City of Carlton must be:

- Eighteen (18) years of age or older;
- A registered voter in the State of Oregon;
- A current, legal resident of the City of Carlton continuously during the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the election.
