- HAZARDOUS WASTE
- APPLIANCES
- MEDICAL WASTE
- BATTERIES
- PAINT
- TIRES
- LIQUID WASTE
- MOTOR OIL
- COOKING OIL
- CONSTRUCTION/REMODELING DEBRIS
- BARRELS THAT DO NOT HAVE BOTH ENDS REMOVED

We know this is a popular event, please remember that Recology provides a limited number of dumpsters and specifies what can be dumped – the city is not involved in those decisions.

Everyone working the event is volunteering. We appreciate everyone's patience as we try to help you as quickly as possible. We understand your time is valuable and sometimes you will have to wait longer than we'd like. Thank you for your assistance and patience to ensure everyone's safety as well as that all trash gets into the right containers.
