
City Community Updates

Carlton PD Arrests 18-year-old on Rape Charges

 On February 11, 2021, the Carlton Police Department arrested an 18year-old male, Dayton area resident, on the following charges: Rape 1, Sodomy 1, Strangulation, Coercion. On February 7, 2021, the Carlton Police Department began an investigation into this incident that occurred in Carlton involving a minor. o Unlawful Firearm Purchase results in Arrest

 On February 6, 2021, the Carlton Police Department was notified by the Oregon State Police Firearms Unit of a denied firearm transaction. During the investigation, it was learned that a 35-yearold Salem resident had provided false information on their firearm transaction record while attempting to purchase a 12-gauge shotgun from a firearm retailer in Carlton on January 14, 2021. It was learned that the Oregon State Police Firearms Unit denied the firearm transaction record due to the suspect's previous convictions for Domestic Assault IV -Misdemeanor and Domestic Strangulation. On February 7, 2021, Carlton Police arrested the suspect without incident for Unlawful Purchase of a Firearm, Providing False Information in Connection with a Transfer of a Firearm, and False Swearing, which is all Class A misdemeanors.

Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card Arrest

 On February 10, 2020, Carlton Officers arrested a Carlton area resident on Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card and Theft of Services charges. An investigation revealed that the suspect had used a credit card number that did not belong to them to make a payment to the City of Carlton without the owner's permission.

- Public Works completed a lateral sewer repair on East Main Street.


