
Valentine's Weekend 2021 Ice Storm























Public Works

- Wennerberg Park is closed until the tree arborists remove hanging limbs that pose a danger to citizens using the park. The projected completion date is February 26. The park will reopen upon completion.
- Tree arborists worked mid-week, removing the hanging limbs from the Atlas
 Cedar tree that broke during the ice storm.
- The Ladd Park Atlas Tree historical sign was damaged from the branches that broke during the ice storm.
- o Hawn Creek Park lost one tree on the SE Corner due to the storm.
- o Privacy slats have begun to be installed on the fence on the East side of the pool.
- o Storm drain emergency work on 3rd and Washington has been completed.
- The Water Plant has been on emergency power since Saturday. PGE is hoping to restore power soon; currently, the water plant runs on a generator with success.
- The wastewater was on emergency power for three days, and we had no overflows or discharges.
- Our contract street sweeper will sweep the downtown corridor core area next week to pick up the pea gravel.


Finance and Administration
