- On March 15, 2021, at about 5:28 p.m.., the Carlton Police Department served a search warrant at a residence in the 400 block of South Pine St. in the City of Carlton. The warrant is part of an ongoing investigation regarding a burglary at Margaritas Mexican Restaurant in Carlton. Various types of evidence were seized from the residence, but no arrests were made at that time. The burglary occurred in February.
 - There is a \$1000.00 reward for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of anyone involved in the burglary.

- The Planning Commission approved the City Site Design Review for a replacement vehicle storage building. The current building has deteriorated past use, the beams are dry-rotted, and the metal has lifted off the roof and door areas. All is beyond repair due to the age of the 59-year-old building.



 The City received from the developer of JR Meadows 2 a prepayment of SDC (system development charges). The payment received was approved by Council in March to help fund the upgrade to the Hawn Creek Pump Station.
