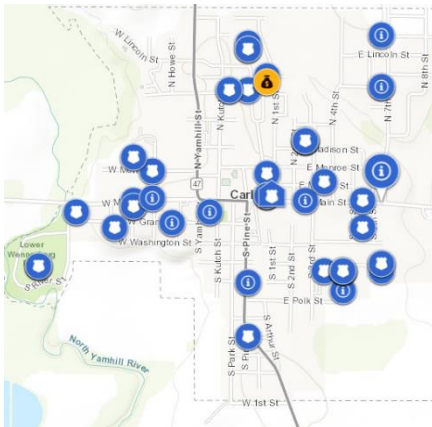

Why is this Event Taking Place?

This **FREE** event is sponsored by the City and Recology to offer opportunities to remove trash, green waste, electronics, and scrap metal before code enforcement action is taken.

How can I participate?

1. Bring your Trash, Green Waste, Electronics, and Scrap metal to Wennerberg Park from 9-1 this Saturday. Look for the Dumpsters!
2. Follow all current COVID regulations regarding face coverings & social distancing. You will have to empty your own vehicle due to current regulations.
3. **Items NOT Accepted:** hazardous waste, appliances, medical waste, motor or cooking oil, barrels that do not have both ends removed & construction/remodeling debris.
