

Cooling Shelter within the City of Carlton

The City of Carlton and American Legion Post 173 are partnering to provide a "Cooling Shelter". The Cooling Center will be located 158 East Main St., Carlton, Oregon 97111, and is located directly across from Carlton City Hall. The shelter will have cold water and bathrooms available. COVID protocols will be followed regarding spacing. The shelter will be available primarily during the hottest times of the day on Saturday, Sunday and Monday if temperatures continue to exceed 100.

The Carlton Police Department is also proactively conducting welfare checks of individuals associated with at risk community members that include but are not limited to families, elderly, and other potential at risk citizens. With 100 plus degree days forecasted for this upcoming weekend, Chief Kevin Martinez, and the Carlton Police Department would like to remind residents to take safety precautions during activities during particularly hot days, especially those that take place outdoors.

Over the course of the next few days, the hot weather and humid conditions are expected to remain in place, We encourage residents to limit the amount of time they are outside as those exposed to extreme heat for a prolonged period of time can fall victim to heat exhaustion or life-threatening heat stroke.

The High school in Yamhill will also be set up as a cooling center. Additional centers throughout the county are listed at the end of these tidbits.

To prevent illness and injuries, the Carlton Police Department recommends the following safety tips from the American Red Cross and National Safety Council:

Heat Safety Tips:

- Hot cars can be deadly. Never leave children or pets in your vehicle. The inside temperature of the car can quickly reach over 100 degrees, even on a 70 degree day.
- Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of fluids, like water.
- Check on family, friends and neighbors who do not have air conditioning, who spend much of their time alone or who are more likely to be affected by the heat.
- If someone doesn't have air conditioning, they should seek relief from the heat during the warmest part of the day in places like libraries, theaters, malls, etc.
- Wear loose-fitting, lightweight, light-colored clothing. Avoid dark colors because they absorb the sun's rays.
- Slow down, stay indoors and avoid strenuous exercise during the hottest part of the day, which is typically around 3 p.m.
- Postpone outdoor games and activities if the temperature is too hot.
- Avoid extreme temperature changes.
- Take frequent breaks if working outdoors.
- Check on animals frequently to ensure that they are not suffering from the heat. Make sure they have plenty of cool water.
- Click here to learn to recognize and treat heat illnesses.

Additional Tips for Parents:

- Limit playtime at peak sun exposure time and familiarize yourself with the signs of heat illnesses.
- Avoid burns. If playground equipment is hot to the touch, it is too hot for your child's bare skin.





- Notices for next month's Planning Commission will be mailed to property owners with 100 feet of the properties on the application. Notices are also posted on the City website on the Planning Commission page.
- Communication provider OnlineNW will be working in the right of way areas (street, sidewalks and public parking areas), on North Pine, East Monroe and North Kutch streets. They will not be digging holes or trenches but boring the fiber optic line under the road. This will eliminate asphalt patching.

If the County cannot go to **LOW Risk**, the pool will not open. There will be no pool passes sold this year due to the gathering restrictions.




Current Case Numbers and vaccine statistics:
