Fourth of July Safety

Oregon law prohibits the possession, use, or sale of any firework that flies into the air, explodes, or travels more than 12 feet horizontally on the ground without a permit issued by the OSFM. Fireworks, commonly called bottle rockets, Roman candles, and firecrackers, are illegal in Oregon without a permit. Officials may seize illegal fireworks and charge offenders with a class B misdemeanor, which could result in a fine of up to \$2,500 per.

Those who misuse fireworks or allow fireworks to cause damage are liable and may be required to pay fire suppression costs or other damage. Parents are also liable for fireworks damage caused by their children.

ILLEGAL FIREWORKS IN OREGON

Illegal: Any firework that flies into the air, explodes, or behaves in an uncontrollable and unpredictable manner.

Warning label may say:
"Shoots Flaming Balls."

LEGAL FIREWORKS IN OREGON

Includes:

- Novelty Device
- Fountains
- Wheel
- Smoke Device
- Flitter Sparkler
- Ground Spinner



BE RESPONSIBLE:

- Soak used fireworks thoroughly in a bucket of water.
- Dispose of used fireworks & debris properly.
- Never re-light "dud" fireworks. Wait 15-20 minutes then soak it in a bucket of water.

BE PREPARED:

- Store fireworks out a children's reach.
- Always read and follow label directions
- Bring pets indoors; they frighten easily
- Always have water on hand

KNOW THE 4 BE'S Of Firework Safety

BE SAFE:

- An adult should always light fireworks.
- Keep matches & lighters away from children.
- Use fireworks outdoors only.
- Light only one firework at a time & move away.
- Keep children & pets away
- Do not throw fireworks or hold them in your hand.

BE AWARE:

- Use only legal fireworks.
- Use fireworks only in legal places.
- Fireworks are prohibited on all beaches, state parks, and state or federal forest lands.

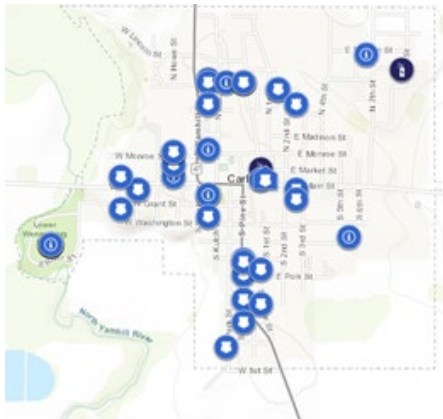

Carlton Market Burglary Investigation Results in two Arrests

On July 1, 2021, Carlton Police Department concluded its investigation of a burglary that occurred at the Carlton Market located on N. Yamhill St. in Carlton on May 29, 2021.

During the course of the investigation, led by Senior Officer Jake Blair, it was determined that 23-year-old William Beam of Lafayette, Oregon, and a 16-year-old male juvenile had driven to the store while it was closed. The male juvenile stole a CO2 cylinder out of the back of a nearby truck and used it to break the glass of one of the front doors of the market. The juvenile then entered the store and stole approximately 10-14 cans of beer. The juvenile then ran back to a vehicle that Beam was driving at which time they drove away from the scene.

On June 24, 2021, the male juvenile was arrested and lodged in the Yamhill County Juvenile Detention Center on the following charges of Burglary II, Conspiracy to Commit Burglary II, Criminal Mischief I (class C felonies), Theft II and Unlawful Entry into a Motor Vehicle (class A misdemeanors), and Criminal Mischief III and Theft III (class C misdemeanors).

On July 1, 2021, Beam was arrested at the Carlton Police Department without incident on the charges of Burglary II and Conspiracy to Commit Burglary II (C felonies) and Theft III (C Misdemeanor). Beam was subsequently cited and released.

Police and City Activity during Heat Wave

(Most of the Follow Up CADS calls are Proactive Welfare Checks related to the hot weather)

Report of the Cooling Center - City of Carlton in Partnership with American Legion Post 173

The Cooling Center provided cold water, movies and bathrooms.

The Carlton police conducted proactive patrols checking on the welfare of Carlton residents during this extreme heat event. We provided cold bottled water to citizens as we drove through town and checked on our parks and water areas to make sure everyone was safe. We contacted approximately 20 potentially high-risk citizens to ensure they were safe, had the ability to stay cool and were aware of the cooling center if they needed it. Additionally, Councilor Shirley Ward-Mullen volunteered to provide any needed transport to the cooling center or any other needs.

In the case of another hot weather event, we will include a first aid station in Cooling Center, use digital display signs for notification of the cooling center and the we will begin to prepare with the addition of a couple more air conditioners. We will also look into Gatorade, orange & apple juice and snacks, sprinkler and/or mist device, additional notifications avenues, pet area at cooling Center and/or providing ice in water if animals stay at home.

While the cooling center was not utilized and there were no heat related calls Friday through Monday, we were glad to have this partnership and center available for our citizens. We were pleased to be able to check in and visit with all of Carlton's residents to ensure everyone's safety during this unusual heat wave.
