# City Hall Is Now Open To The Public

# **Public Works**

#### Water/Sewer

- The Meadowlake transmission line project has completed over 3,000 feet of replacement line
  - This project will replace over 15,500 feet of water transmission pipeline.
     Trenchline Excavation is doing the project. The The City received a grant for \$7,150,000 for this project which was to cover all aspects of the work including engineering, permitting, construction and change orders. The City is also entering an agreement with Yamhill County to share a portion of the paving cost for the project.
- Water leaks repaired on Gilwood
- The Hawn Creek Pump Station pre-bid meeting was held on July 13<sup>th</sup>
- The mainline on Washington Street was flushed and a new hydrant installed at Washington and 1<sup>st</sup> street.

#### **Construction**

- > JR Meadows will be doing a Storm Drainage test July 16<sup>th</sup>.
- Sidewalk replacement on Monroe St. slated for the end of July.



## Fire Safety

City crews will be continuing to work in parks and rights-of-way — and County crews on the rail corridor - to cut vegetation to reduce fire risk.

#### **Illegal Fireworks Search Warrant Served in Carlton**

On July 9, 2021, at about 2 p.m., the Carlton Police Department executed a search warrant at a residence in the 900 block of S. Mason St., in the city limits of Carlton.

The search warrant was in association with the illegal use of fireworks by individual(s) associated with the residence. The illegal fireworks that were being ignited included firecrackers, bottle rockets and mortars. The

mortars and bottle rockets were propelled into the air landing on nearby roofs, roadways, and dry yard vegetation.


Due to the hot weather conditions, dry vegetation, and other highly flammable fuel sources it was critical to stop the discharging of these illegal fireworks for the safety of the neighborhood as well as the overall safety of the community.

The individuals that reside at the residence where the search warrant was served have been involved in an ongoing neighborhood for the last three years.

During the search of the residence a large box of various illegal fireworks were located, in addition, there was evidence related to the use and possession of methamphetamine.


