Meadowlake Transmission Line

Trenchline Excavation has replaced 32,435 feet (6.14 miles) of water transmission pipeline.

Approximately 1,776 feet of ductile iron pipe has been installed. We have about 426 more feet to install. The remaining project items, like water service installation, are scheduled to finish in November/December.



The City received a grant for \$7,150,000 for this project which was to cover all aspects of the work including engineering, permitting, construction and change orders.

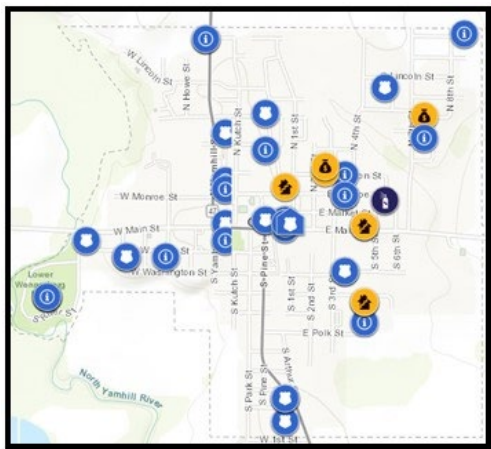

Search Warrant Related to Stalking of Neighbor Served in Carlton

On November 9, 2021, at about 9:30 a.m., the Carlton Police Department served a search warrant at a residence in the 900 block of S. Mason St., in the city limits of Carlton.

The search warrant was in association with a stalking investigation that began during the last week of October 2021. The stalking involved the use of a laser pointer which the suspect repeatedly used to point at two victims and into the victim's residence over a two-week period.

The suspect was also arrested for violating a restraining order related to one of the victims.

The individuals that reside at the residence where the search warrant was served have been involved in an ongoing neighborhood dispute for the last three years.

During the search of the residence and an associated vehicle, a laser pointer and evidence related to the use and possession of over 3 grams of methamphetamine was located.

On November 9, 2021, 44-year-old Anthony Thompson was arrested on the following charges:

- Stalking x 2
- Violation of a Restraining Order x 1
- Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine) – Misdemeanor

Carlton Police Department served another search warrant at this same residence also involving Thompson as the primary suspect on July 9, 2021, at which time illegal fireworks and methamphetamine were seized.

This most recent case is still under investigation.

Theft Prevention Safety Tips



This is the time of year Law Enforcement and communities see an increase in theft crimes. These thefts often occur during the early morning hours between 2 a.m. and 5 a.m. The Carlton Police Department would like to share the following prevention information regarding our "LOCK IT or LOSE IT program.

Lock It or Lose It Campaign. The Carlton, Oregon Police Department reminds citizens about its "LOCK IT or LOSE IT" program. The intent of the program is to promote awareness in hopes of eliminating thefts of

vehicles as well as property being stolen from automobiles occurring in the City of Carlton and surrounding area.

The Carlton Police Department, as do all law enforcement agencies across the country, periodically conduct theft investigations from vehicles that seem to come in waves throughout certain periods of the year. Many of the thefts are from vehicles that were left unlocked. Items taken in these quickly committed crimes range from spare change to wallets, personal/business documents, electronics, and firearms

In most, if not all instances, these crimes can be prevented by simply locking car doors, assuring all the windows are completely shut, removing all valuable items or what might be perceived as containing valuables such as backpacks or other bags, keeping change and charging cords out of sight, and NEVER leave keys inside the vehicle.

Getting in the mindset of locking doors to your home, garages, and vehicles is the first step of minimizing the chance of becoming a crime victim.

Carlton Police Department has "LOCK IT or LOSE IT" yard signs available for residents to display in their yard if they would like to help encourage a strong community prevention mindset. This program supports the mission of the Carlton Police Department's dedication to the community by proactively solving problems and protecting life and property through education and prevention. "Police & Community Together", can and will make our community safer and more livable.

Please be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious activity immediately to your local law enforcement agency.

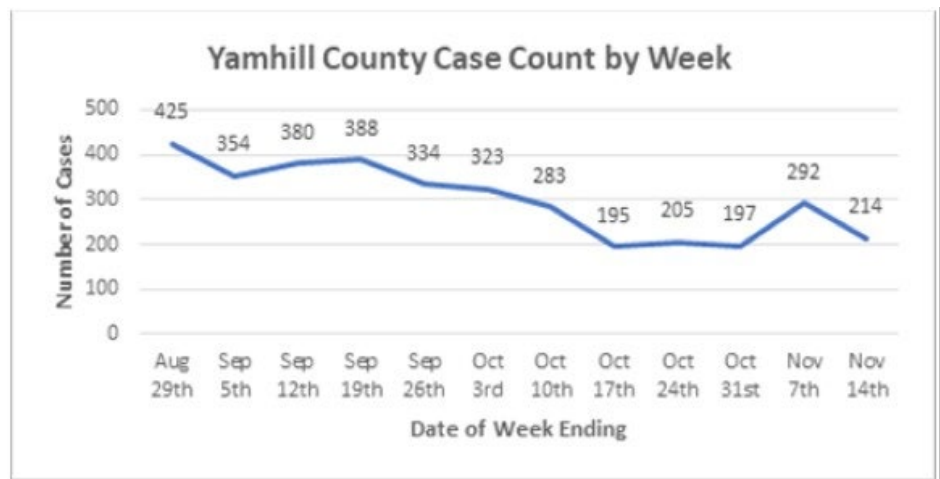
