Public Works



Meadowlake Transmission line

Approximately 7,400 feet of one lane along Meadowlake Road has been paved. The shoulder rock along Panther Creek Road has been installed. We are working to connect properties to the new Mainline.

The remaining project items, like water service installation, are

scheduled to finish in November/December. Approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ of the line from water plant to concrete reservoir is online with all new water pipe.



This project will replace 32,435 feet (6.14 miles) of water transmission pipeline. Trenchline Excavation is doing the project. The City received a grant for \$7,150,000 for this project which was to cover all aspects of the work including engineering, permitting, construction and change orders.

Development

The Brooklyn Terrace Project is underway and water and sewer are being installed this week.

Streets

Sidewalk project on Monroe St. is complete except for paving.


