Lower Park Closed Today Due to Flooding

Meadowlake Transmission Line

Trenchline Excvation has replaced 32,435 feet (6.14 miles) of water transmission pipeline.

This week approximately 717 feet of ductile iron pipe has been installed. The concrete reservoir is lined and back online. Most services are now hooked up to the new mainline. The remaining project items, like water service installation, are scheduled to finish in November/December.





The City received a grant for \$7,150,000 for this project which was to cover all aspects of the work including engineering, permitting, construction and change orders.




