The Carlton Code Corner

Let's talk about noise this week.

In the City Code citizens are asked to refrain from creating, assisting, or permitting loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise in the city of Carlton. Some specific examples include:



- Animals that make frequent noise
- Unnecessarily loud vehicles due to disrepair or modification
- Demolition or repair of buildings after six p.m. or before seven a.m. (unless granted a special permit)

- Sirens or horns outside of emergency vehicles or necessary warning of danger to others respectively
- Noise amplification devices that disturb others in the vicinity outside of permitted events and gatherings

ADA curb ramps Construction in 2022

ODOT is installing ADA compliant curb ramps on the corners of several intersections in Carlton. ODOT plans to construct one corner of an intersection at a time, with up to five intersections under construction at once. When construction starts, expect ODOT crews working during the day and at night as needed. During construction, the project webpage or Tripcheck.com will have the most up to date information about impacts. OR 47 realignment design is underway
