Elections

City Councilors are elected by their community to be representatives. A city councilor provides leadership and support for their community. One of the most important jobs of a council is to work closely with the administration of their city. They do this by making policy decisions for local issues, approving city budgets, proposing code updates and ordinances, and regulating health and safety issues, among a multitude of tasks.

The City of Carlton currently has 3 councilor at large positions open for this election cycle, which would start a 4-year term beginning January 1, 2023.

OR 47 Realignment Update

Thank you all who joined us on August 9th for the first quarterly update from ODOT on the OR47 realignment.

Following the presentation, the City Council decided to have monthly meetings to provide a venue for integrative community-driven engagement and decision making. The purpose of this engagement plan is to develop community consensus on options for the OR 47 realignment that will fit the character of Carlton and meet the community's goals. More information will be forthcoming and rest assured – if you can't make a meeting, other opportunities for input will be available.

The following is an outline of the engagement plan. ***This outline may change as circumstances and information evolves.***

- Monthly Meetings of the Lead Committee which includes Council, Ad Hoc, Planning, and Envision Carlton. Meetings will be open to the public for community input on the specified meeting topic
 - Opportunities for email and other input opportunities will also be conducted
- Each meeting would have a singular topic focus and be 2 hours in length
- ODOT personnel will be invited to the monthly meetings to provide subject matter expertise and assistance with the pros and cons of generated options
- Initial Monthly Meeting Topic Suggestions based on Community Input:
 - Meeting #1 – Discussion of historical presented alternatives/options
Goal: Determine how community currently functions in project area v. when options were presented
 - Meeting #2 – Traffic Control Option Discussion
Goal: Discuss community priority - slow down vehicle speed in project area
 - Meeting #3 – Crosswalk/Pedestrian Safety Options
Goal: Discuss community priority – multi-modal (pedestrian/bike/ADA) safety (this can include bike lanes)
 - Meeting #4 – On-Street Parking for economic enhancement and enjoyment of the downtown core
Goal: Discuss community priority – preserve economic vitality in the downtown core
 - Meeting #5 – Landscaping/Beautification
Goal: Discuss community priority – slow down traffic with visual clues and enhance the downtown core environment for economic vitality
 - Future meetings to be determined

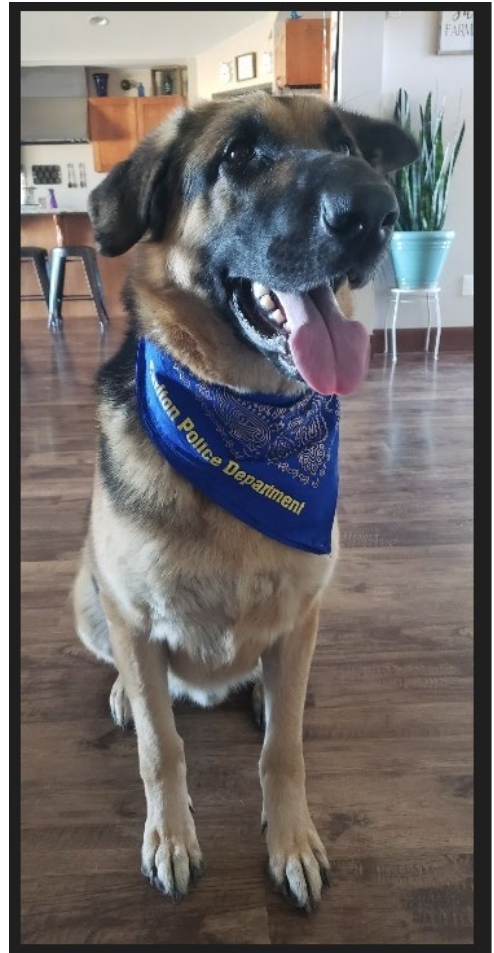
Police
