Summer is here! Remember outside water conservation!

Water

- Meadow lake transmission line is completed we are looking at a short round of changes orders to close out the project within the grant funding that remains
- Water plant upgrade to the clearwell is complete and we are in process of purchasing materials for the PLC upgrade and filter upgrade
- Panther creek reservoir dredging project has been has success lately with quantity of material removed this project will probably go until mid-October

Sewer

- Recently purchased aerators are running and making a big difference in our lagoon treatment system
- We are still in lagoon upgrade engineering phase and have recently encountered some archeological sites that might factor in the timing of this project
- Planning phase of Headworks project is proceeding
- Hawn creek pump station no activity last two weeks

Streets/Construction

- Please be advised- East Main St. is currently under construction. Traffic control is in place for East Main Street. East Main work on south side of Main demoing the sidewalk and forming up for curb and gutter

Code Corner

Code Enforcement would like to help citizens remain in compliance with the following guidelines for RVs and Trailer Houses:

What is permitted

- A Recreational Vehicle or Trailer House for a period up to 72 hours on public streets is permitted as long as clear vision is maintained for pedestrians and traffic. After the 72 hours expire, the vehicle or trailer must be moved. Failure to do so may result in citation or towing
- Recreational Vehicles or Trailer Houses can be parked on private property for an indefinite amount of time if the vehicle or trailer doesn't cause any obstruction of sight and no one lives in it
- Camping in a recreational vehicle or trailer house on private property on a temporary base must be approved by the City of Carlton with a Temporary Trailer Parking Permit

What is NOT permitted

- Overnight sleeping or living in Recreational Vehicles and Trailer Houses on Public Streets at any time
- Permanent camping/living in a Recreational Vehicle or Trailer House on private property without an approved temporary permit
- Permanent storage or parking of utility trailers, house or vacation trailers in yard areas
