Construction within the City


- Public Works building grading is complete.


Curb Ramp Upgrades

Code Corner

The City of Carlton has multiple vineyards inside City Limits located within agriculture areas. During harvest season in early fall, the neighbors hear the boom of bird cannons during the daylight hours. If you are new to Carlton, you might not recognize the sound.

The cannons are used to deter the birds and prevent them from consuming the ripened fruit. The cannon is a sound-emitting device that frightens and disorientates the birds and prevents them from eating the grape crop.

- The cannons are typically used a few weeks out of the year depending on the weather and bird pressure.
- The agriculture crops are the primary source of revenue for the landowner
- The cannons are placed shooting away from the residences to minimize the noise as much as possible

After harvest, winemakers will not use the cannons again until next year's harvest season.
