



City of Carlton Public Pool Rules

HEALTH

- Protect our water- Please do not use the pool if you have had diarrhea in the past two weeks, or a disease communicable by water.
- Shower your child and yourself- take a cleansing shower before entering the pool and after using the toilet.
- Swimmers who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Immuno-compromised individuals should use caution when using a public pool.
- Water and alcohol don't mix- No person under the influence of alcohol may use the pool.

SAFETY

- No running or rough play.
- No glass or plastic that can shatter is allowed in the pool area.
- No food or drink is allowed in the pool; however, food may be eaten in the grass area.
- No diving allowed except in designated diving areas. Ask a lifeguard for assistance if needed.
- No back flips from diving board.
- No life jackets or flotation devices in the deep end of the pool.
- Patrons must be able to swim two widths of the pool to use the deep end of pool.
- No animals allowed in the pool area.
- Children 8 and under and non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult in the water.
- The staff and management reserve the right to close the pool in cases of unsafe weather conditions, water quality or other situations warranting closure.

GENERAL

- A family is defined as a parent (or guardian) and children ages 17 years and younger living in the same household.
- Zumba fitness class is not included in the purchase of a pool pass. This class is paid for at time of service.
- A Carlton resident is any resident that has a Carlton home address. They will be charged the Carlton resident rate at the pool. Out of district rates apply to any other city of residence.
- All pool reservations must be paid at time of reservation, and they are non-refundable.
- For all private pool reservations, an adult MUST be in attendance for the whole rental period, and children six and under and non-swimmers must still be accompanied by an adult in the water.
- Scooters, bikes, shoes with wheels and skateboards are not allowed anywhere on premises.
